If you have not yet heard, three of our parishioners were tragically involved in a fatal car accident on Monday evening.

According to reports, the crash occurred around 8:45 p.m. on Wheatland Road when two men were allegedly racing and struck the victims' vehicle, causing it to overturn. As a result of the accident, three members of our parish family lost their lives – 12 year old Lucas Reyna, his mother, Maria Cristina Rodriguez, a 7:30am choir member, and his grandmother Teresa Rodriguez.

Please keep the victims, their loved ones, and all those affected by this tragedy in your prayers. May God grant them eternal rest and bring comfort, strength, and peace to their families during this difficult time.

The parish will be providing a Funeral Mass and reception for the family. If you would like to make a monetary contribution to help support the family during this difficult time, please stop by the church office and ask for me.

2 men arrested after street racing crash killed 3 people, including a child, in Duncanville, police say

Street racing caused a two-vehicle crash that killed three people and injured one other, officials said. Victims include two women and one boy, police said.

DUNCANVILLE, Texas — Two men were arrested for street racing after a crash that killed two women and a boy in Duncanville, police said.

According to the Duncanville Police Department, officers were called to the accident at about 8:45 p.m. June 8 at the intersection of West Wheatland Road and South Cedar Ridge Drive. Police found that a white Chrysler 300 and a gray Toyota Corolla were involved in the crash.

Police say two women and two boys were inside the Corolla at the time of the crash. Both women died at the scene, and both boys were taken to local hospitals, where one was pronounced dead. The other boy is hospitalized with critical injuries.

The child victim was identified by his family as 12-year-old Lucas Reyna, his mother Maria Rodriguez and his grandmother Teresa Rodriguez.
